- ISCF has been a beacon of hope and light in Jamaica since 1948, when a staff worker from Intervarsity Christian Fellowship Canada, Miss Cathy Nicoll, visited Jamaica and helped in starting the movement (ISCF) in six schools.

- ISCF exist in schools to bring students to Christ and strengthen their Christian witness.

Christian Teachers In Action

- Christian Teachers in Action (CTIA), with its motto "With God all things are possible", is a prayer, discipleship, equipping, and fellowship collaborative movement institution in Jamaica. This movement was founded by Mrs. Donnette Norman (teacher and ISCF staff advisor at Wolmer's Girls' School) in March 2006 and officially launched at the Shortwood Teachers' College.

- Christian Teachers In Action is aimed at having our teachers foster a wholesome relationship among each other, share creative ideas, be disciplined and equipped for service, and corporately seek God for divine intervention in our schools, colleges, and churches across the nation. This is to the end that our creative energies and those of whom we are called to serve be released to the glory of God.

Passion and Purity

- Passion and Purity was founded by Mr. and Mrs. Andrew and Donnette Norman and officially launched in September 2008 at The Wolmer's Girls' School.
- The mission of Passion and Purity is to help individuals, primarily children and youth, to discover, accept, develop, and creatively express their God-given passion with purity of motive, thought, and action by embracing Godly principles - hence its motto: "Finding your passion... embracing your purity". This is done in the context of schools, churches, communities and the media.
